Emirates Aviation university signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Emirates Engineering; this will provide our students who have successfully completed theoretical classroom training at EAU to undertake a two-year Practical Maintenance Experience (PME) at Emirates Engineering Maintenance Section, one of the world's largest and most sophisticated aircraft maintenance. UAE Nationals at EK Engineering who have obtained full GCAA Aircraft Maintenance Engineer Licence can now opt for a one-year top-up degree accredited by Knowledge and Human Development Authority (KHDA) on a Part-time basis at EAU. EAU will also assist in obtaining accreditation from KHDA for aircraft maintenance training programmes run by EK engineering, and award EAU Advanced Diplomas.

EAU Camps for High school Students

Emirates Aviation University hosted their 2nd consecutive year of Aviation Camps conducted during the summer and winter break. More than 100+ students participated from schools around the UAE and globally.

The camp, designed for senior high school students of grade 11 & 12, gave an insight on different aspects of Aviation engineering such as aerodynamics, electricals, electronics, hydraulics, flight instruments, materials and maintenance.



Boeing supports Water Rocket Challenge

Boeing, in its mission to promote science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) education in the Middle East, supported the annual Water Rocket Competition hosted by Emirates Aviation University (EAU). The event took place at the EAU campus with over 223 students from 23 schools across the UAE participating.

Contestants were asked to design and construct a rocket that can achieve the greatest distance from a launch angle of 45 degrees, and were given exactly two hours to build, test and submit their entries. Representatives from EAU and the Boeing Middle East Research and Technology team headed the judging panel and selected the International Community School for first place, and Islamia English School for second place.

Smart Agricultural Robotic Competition

EAU School of Engineering, hosted Smart Agricultural Robotic Competition between EAU, Coventry University UK and Deakin University Australia. During the one-week event students constructed a robot from scratch and also presented and demonstrated the project.

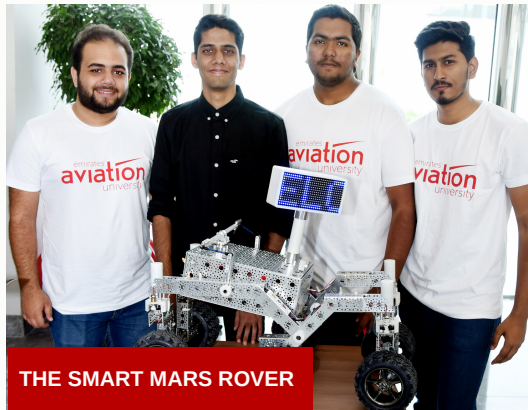

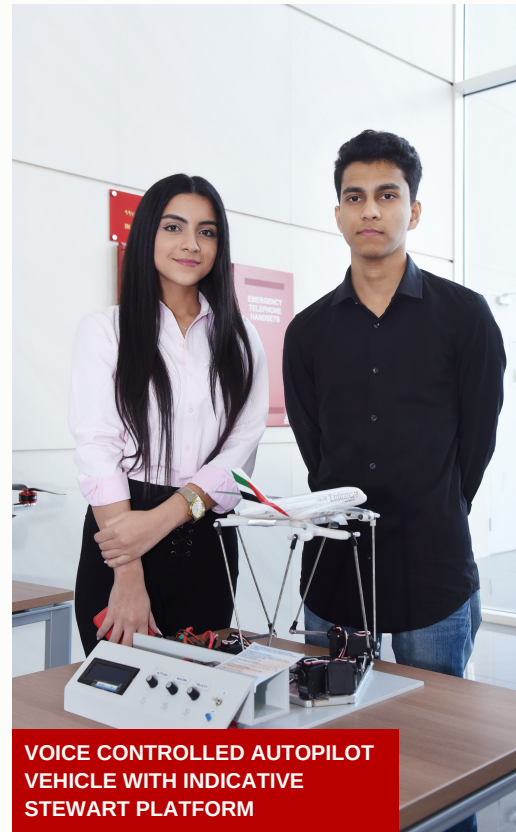

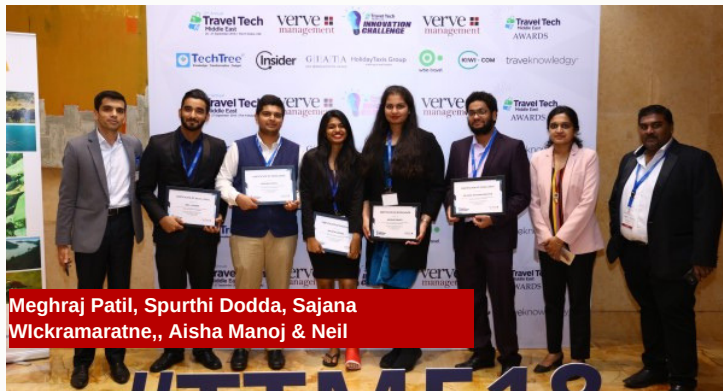
BBA Internship Programmes
